ST. KITTS AND NEVIS CITIZENSHIP BY DESCENT

Listed below are the following requirements for applying for citizenship by descent:

1. Parent's and grandparent's birth certificate (must be certified by a Justice of the Peace of Notary Public)
2. Applicant's Birth Certificate.
 3. An original Police Certificate for Applicants over the age of 16 from all the places they have lived in the last three (3) months.
4. Money order for CAD\$ 75.00 or EC\$150.
5. Two (2) Passport size photographs (The size of the photographs is 1.77" x 1.38" (45mm x 35mm).
