- 2. A scanned copy of Applicant's valid and expired St. Kitts and Nevis Driver's Licence.
- 3. Applicant's current mailing address and phone number.

Please email the following information to the office of the Consulate General of St. Kitts and Nevis to Info@CGStKittsNevis.ca and mail a money order in the amount of **CAD\$20.00** for processing, payable to **The Consulate General of St. Kitts and Nevis.**

The request will be made to St. Kitts and Nevis Police Force, Traffic Department upon receiving all the required information.

A notification will be sent to the email address provided after the completion of the application and if any additional information is required the Applicant will be contacted via the email address or the phone number provided.
